Definition of "*Anger*"*: "*a feeling of great annoyance or antagonism as the result of some real or supposed grievance; rage; wrath.*" The consequences of works of the flesh are anger which produces emotional and physical detriment.

Definition of "Angel"*: "theol one of a class of spiritual beings attendant upon God. In medieval angelology they are divided by rank into nine orders: seraphim, cherubim, thrones, dominations (or dominions), virtues, powers, principalities (or princedoms), archangels, and angels; a divine messenger from God; a guardian spirit; a person, esp a woman, who is kind, pure, or beautiful." An outcome of the Fruit of the Spirit is an angel of kindness, pure and beautiful divine messenger from Yahweh.
