When we humbly seek the LORD, humbly obey the LORD, and humbly serve the LORD in our Valley Place moments, the LORD'S Presence will stand near us. The LORD could have easily told Ezekiel to meet him in a familiar place, but many people will not focus on the LORD with accustomed surroundings.

If Ezekiel did not arise and go out to the valley, he would have never seen or experience the Presence of the LORD. The valley is a hard place, a dry place, a lonely place that we must go out to in order to see and have understanding of the Presence of the LORD. Many of us would had argued or told the LORD, "Why do you want me there in the valley?" "Could I not go to the mountaintop?" "LORD, the valley is too hard, dry, and lonely; I need my friends, family, and fortune if I am going to such a place!"

Most people want to feel comfortable in meeting the LORD, but this is not how the LORD does things when we are serious about seeing His glory and Presence. Many people want to take their friends, family, fortune, or today their I-pads, I-pods, Androids, computers and electronic devices of all kinds to the valley. The Valley Place moments are times we need to forgo all distractions, and we arise and go out to the hard, dry, and lonely place to meet the Presence of the LORD. As we humbly seek, obey, and serve the LORD in our Valley Place moments, He will show up and come near us.

We need the Valley Place meeting with the LORD for the next assignment task from the LORD we are going to encounter for the training, education, teaching, and wisdom from the LORD to overcome in our spiritual battles.

Exodus 19:1-25 (http://www.bibleview.org/en/Bible/Moses/MosesSinai/)

20 The LORD descended to the top of Mount Sinai and called Moses to the top of the mountain. Therefore, Moses went up 21 and the LORD said to him, "Go down and warn the people so they do not force their way through to see the LORD and many of them perish. 22 Even the priests, who approach the LORD, must consecrate themselves, or the LORD will break out against them."

Arise - physical and/or spiritual actions in compliance to the words of the LORD.

Go out - the direction of leaving a place in order to get to another location.

Valley - a hard, dry, and lonely place either physical and/or spiritually.

There I will speak to you – as we follow His directions, the LORD will speak to us in the valley.

To see and have knowledge of the hand and Presence of the LORD, we must arise and go out to our Valley Place (where the LORD has told us to go), which is a hard, dry, and lonely place resulting in meeting and seeing His glory and the LORD speaking to us.
