Typed on Sunday, September 30, 2012 Last night the Most High and Exalted One the Creator of the universe Adonai Elohim El Gibbor El Shaddai El Elyon LORD of HOSTS sent two dreams to me.

The first dream was a man sitting on a throne-like in a chair and there were people inside the room along with this man sitting in the throne-like chair. Then I was speaking to someone in the room, and I heard a person say, "Psalm 15", and another person said, "Psalm 98." Then I said in return to these individuals, "Psalm 98 and Psalm 15." End of first dream.

In the second dream, my husband and I were lying on the floor of our home and I looked out the window, and a tornado was spinning just outside the window. We both kept down lying flat on the floor, and we both were surprised to see the tornado come up so quickly because the sky was not dark. The tornado moved from the front window going toward the east–side of our home, and we kept looking in amazement of the winds whirling around. Also, inside the tornado twisting along in the winds where something resembling leaflets of paper it had picked up from somewhere. Then the tornado subsided and stopped. As the Ruach HaKodesh, the Set-apart Spirit, the Holy Spirit directed me this morning as the Most High and Exalted One Adonai Elohim woke me up, I read Psalm 98 and Psalm 15, and this is the warning from the Creator and King of the universe is saying to all of us through His Word the Holy Bible.

Psalm 98

A Psalm.

1 O sing to the Lord a new song, for He has done marvelous things; His right hand and His holy arm have wrought salvation for Him.

2 The Lord has made known His salvation; His righteousness has He openly shown in the sight of the nations.

3 He has [earnestly] remembered His mercy and loving-kindness, His truth and His faithfulness toward the house of Israel; all the ends of the earth have witnessed the salvation of our God.

4 Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth; break forth and sing for joy, yes, sing praises!

5 Sing praises to the Lord with the lyre, with the lyre and the voice of melody.

6 With trumpets and the sound of the horn make a joyful noise before the King, the Lord!

7 Let the sea roar, and all that fills it, the world, and those who dwell in it!

8 Let the rivers clap their hands; together let the hills sing for joy

9 Before the Lord, for He is coming to judge [and rule] the earth; with righteousness will He judge [and rule] the world, and the peoples with equity.

From Psalm 98, the Most High and Exalted One is going to show He is Ruler and Sovereign over the whole earth and universe by His:

- 1. Right hand.
- 2. Holy arm.
- 3. Victory that He won.
- 4. Showing and manifesting his victory.
- 5. Display of triumph in the sight of the nations.

The El Gibbor, El Elyon, El Shaddai, Adonai, Elohim, Yahweh, Yahuah, Elohim of HOSTS is going to show the entire whole world of nations that He keeps and is mindful of His covenant of steadfastness toward the house of Israel.

All the ends of the earth beheld the victory of Adonai Elohim. This means all the countries coming against Israel will see and feel the victory of the Most High and Exalted One.

As the results of Yahweh Adonai Elohim Creator and King of the victorious battle over His enemies, there are going to be:

- 1. Shouting to Adonai Elohim.
- 2. Joyous songs of praise.

Because in verse 9 of Psalm chapter 98 says: Before the Lord, for He is coming to judge [and rule] the earth; with righteousness will He judge [and rule] the world, and the peoples with equity.

In Psalm 15 the Holy Bible tells us the ones who are going to survive the Great Tribulation and the Day of the LORD, and will live in His Holy Hill, Mountain and Kingdom. Both Psalm 98 and Psalm 15 are tied together by the fact the Messiah is coming and we need to become Spiritual prepared and ready before He comes.

Psalm 15 A Psalm of David.

1 Lord, who shall dwell [temporarily] in Your tabernacle? Who shall dwell [permanently] on Your holy hill?

2 He who walks and lives uprightly and blamelessly, who works rightness and justice and speaks and thinks the truth in his heart,

3 He who does not slander with his tongue, nor does evil to his friend, nor takes up a reproach against his neighbor;

4 In whose eyes a vile person is despised, but he who honors those who fear the Lord (who revere and worship Him); who swears to his own hurt and does not change;

5 [He who] does not put out his money for interest [to one of his own people] and who will not take a bribe against the innocent. He who does these things shall never be moved.

The Creator of the earth and universe, King, Master, Savior, Deliverer, Rock, Ruler, Redeemer, Most High and Exalted One is going to soon show all the nations coming against Israel and His people that He is Supreme over the earth and universe. All people will soon see and know the Most High and Exalted One Yahweh Adonai Elohim that He deserves all the most high esteem, honor, praise and worship. The Most High and Exalted One Yahweh Adonai Elohim is going show His righteous wrath of power against His enemies, and the LORD of HOSTS will be victorious.

I bring near My righteousness [in the deliverance of Israel], it will not be far off; and My salvation shall not tarry. And I will put salvation in Zion, for Israel My glory [yes, give salvation in Zion and My glory to Israel].
