"See", I said to this woman sitting on the chair, "This has happened before and you are going to be okay." The woman then told me, "I have kidney stones." I asked her, "What were you drinking?" She replied, "I was drinking a strawberry smoothie." By the time the cleaning custodian finished cleaning the floor, the woman had calm down more as we talked. 


