The word "if" is a small word with big consequences. In the Holy Bible from the King James Version the word "if" occurs 1595 times in 1420 verses (Blue Letter Bible. "Dictionary and Word Search for 'if' in the KJV". Blue Letter Bible. 1996-2010. 27 Dec 2010. <<http://www.blueletterbible.org>). The definitions of the word "if" are *in case that; granting or supposing that; on condition that: or a condition, requirement, or stipulation.* (www.Dictionary.com). The LORD God Almighty has conditions, requirements and stipulations for becoming one of His humble obedient clay vessel servants. We will look from God's Word the Holy Bible who will encounter the "if" factor, and about His specifications and consequences of the "if" factor.

Pharaoh encounter the "if" factor with the LORD God Almighty through Moses. The LORD God Almighty sent Moses to warn Pharaoh of pending destruction if he did not let the children of Israel to worship the LORD God Almighty. Because of his hard and stubborn heart, these plagues were pronounced upon Pharaoh with dire repercussions.

Exodus 4:23 - *And I say unto thee, Let my son go, that he may serve me: and if thou refuse to let him go, behold, I will slay thy son, [even] thy firstborn.*

Exodus 8:2 - *And if thou refuse to let [them] go, behold, I will smite all thy borders with frogs:*

Exodus 8:21 - *Else, if thou wilt not let my people go, behold, I will send swarms [of flies] upon thee, and upon thy servants, and upon thy people, and into thy houses: and the houses of the Egyptians shall be full of swarms [of flies], and also the ground whereon they [are].*

Exodus 10:4 - *Else, if thou refuse to let my people go, behold, to morrow will I bring the locusts into thy coast:*

CHRISTIANITY IS JEWISH

"There is the need to realize that because man believed Satan rather than God – separation from God has occurred (Isaiah 59:2). There is the need to realize that God has provided a way back to Himself – a way to bring man to God. "Shalom" – peace – actually means "to repair that which was broken." Our relationship with God was broken. God chose Israel and showed them the way to come to Him – with the lamb – the sacrifice. And He told Israel to share this message with the world. There is the need to believe God is here. "He that comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him." The prophet Isaiah, when he saw God high and lifted up, realized that he, Isaiah, was "undone" (destroyed) in the presence of a holy God (Isaiah 6). There is the need to realize that we have broken God's commandments (Jeremiah 31:31- 32, we have sinned (Psalm 51: ; Ecclesiastes 7:20; Ezekiel 18:)"

What is the significance of Beth Peor?

Deuteronomy 4:45-47 (New King James Version)

These *are* the testimonies, the statutes, and the judgments which Moses spoke to the children of Israel after they came out of Egypt, on this side of the Jordan, in the valley opposite Beth Peor, in the land of Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt at Heshbon, whom Moses and the children of Israel defeated after they came out of Egypt. And they took possession of his land and the land of Og king of Bashan, two kings of the Amorites, who *were* on this side of the Jordan, toward the rising of the sun,

1. Why did the king become "furious, and his anger burned within him" toward Queen Vashti? Esther 1

ANSWER: Esther 1:12 - *But when they conveyed the king's order to Queen Vashti, she refused to come. This made the king furious, and he burned with anger.* NLT

2. In Job chapter 42, what did Job confess due to his lack of understanding the things of the LORD God Almighty?

ANSWER: Job 42: 1 - 6: *Then Job replied to the Lord: "I know that you can do anything, and no one can stop you. You asked, 'Who is this that questions my wisdom with such ignorance?' It is I—and I was talking about things I knew nothing about, things far too wonderful for me. You said, 'Listen and I will speak! I have some questions for you, and you must answer them.' I had only heard about you before, but now I have seen you with my own eyes. I take back everything I said, and I sit in dust and ashes to show my repentance."* NLT

3. Jesus / Yeshua went up to Jerusalem while the "Passover of the Jews" was at hand, what did He find happening in the temple? John 2

ANSWER: John 2:13 - *It was nearly time for the Jewish Passover celebration, so Jesus went to Jerusalem. 14 In the Temple area he saw merchants selling cattle, sheep, and doves for sacrifices; he also saw dealers at tables exchanging foreign money. 15 Jesus made a whip from some ropes and chased them all out of the Temple. He drove out the sheep and cattle, scattered the money changers' coins over the floor; and turned over their tables. 16 Then, going over to the people who sold doves, he told them, "Get these things out of here. Stop turning my Father's house into a marketplace!"* NLT
